There Are Several Opportunities To Collaborate With The Alabama Science Festival

- Open your business for a demonstration during festival week. Select a day and time to invite people to see how you use science or technology. This can be anything from building a rocket to baking a loaf of bread – Science is EVERYWHERE! This is a perfect opportunity to highlight your innovative programs and activities. Showcase how you explore new ways of creating, thinking, learning and communicating.
- Become a presenter and give a talk. You may be surprised at how many curious minds want to know what YOU know. Just pick your topic and title. There are several ways we can present your talk; your venue, at the STEAMfest 2025 event at UAH Campus or in classrooms at local schools. We provide local teachers with a “menu” of talks and speakers so they can choose what will best fit their students. Just let us know your topic and the age group for which it is appropriate.
- Have a table at STEAMfest 2025. This is an all-day event at UAH on October 25th, 2025. Even if you have another presentation during festival week, we want you at STEAMfest 2025. This free event will draw thousands from our communities for a day of celebrating science.
- In addition to our live events, we invite you to provide us with video content that we can post to the festival website. These videos will live on our site and also may be shared with other science festivals around North America.
- You can donate or contribute science kits that we will distribute throughout our communities. In 2020 we distributed over 1,400 free science kits to students and their families, many through our partnership with the Huntsville/Madison County Public Library System.
